Decision Notice for S22A Collaboration agreement for Joint Protective Services

1. Purpose

1.1 To approve the signature of the Section 22A agreement relating to the ongoing collaboration between Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire and Hertfordshire of Joint Protective Services and for the lead force to change from Cambridgeshire to Bedfordshire.

2. Background

2.1 At the BCH Alliance meeting on Monday 9 December the Chief Constables presented their recommendation that the proposed S22A collaborative agreement for Joint Protective Services met operational requirements (Appendix 5a). At the same meeting Chief Executives presented their recommendation that the agreement was legally sound and compliant with Home Office statutory guidance for collaboration (Appendix 5b).

3. Recommendation

3.1 The Board approve the signing of the S22A collaborative agreement on Joint Protective Services.
